### Fife Swim Center

The Fife Swim Center reopened in June after an \$840,000 renovation. The pool is at 5410 20th St. E.

The renovation updated the entry and locker rooms of the 1985 building, covering about 3,000 square feet.

“The primary goal was to make the facility more user-friendly,” said Kurt Reuter, director of Fife Parks, Recreation and Community Services.

Rest rooms were integrated into the men’s and women’s locker rooms, new lockers were installed, and the changing areas were enlarged. Two new family changing rooms were also built.

Other improvements include updated lobby and reception areas, mechanical upgrades to the lobby, new lighting, and office and meeting room additions.
